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### August 24<sup>th</sup> 2014 21<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time - Year A - Matthew 16 : 13 - 20

In this week's gospel we read of Jesus asking the question "who do people say that the Son of Man is?" He feels the need to clarify where he is - has he established himself? Communicated His message? Been who he is called to be?" Peter his disciple affirms him as 'the Christ', 'the Son of the living God'. Jesus has found someone to whom he can hand over his mission. We hear Jesus confirm Peter as steeped in the Spirit. It is very important that as leaders we see the link between Spirit, Authority and Leadership.

"Who do you say that I am". This is possibly the most important question that Jesus puts to us? In your heart of hearts, how do you answer this question?
