March 16th 2014 2nd Sunday of Lent - Year A - Matthew 17: 1 - 9

In this week's gospel we see Jesus appearing in glory to the apostles. He took Peter, James and John up a high mountain before He was transfigured in their presence. This is a symbol of the painful journey the apostles must make with Jesus. On their journey with Jesus they get covered by a cloud and yet it is from within the cloud that they experience a renewed commitment to Him.

When are the times in our lives that a dark cloud has covered us in shadows and we found it hard to keep our commitments? Who were the Jesus people who brought us back into the light? When did we help someone to a new life experience by being there for them as Jesus was for the apostles?
