January 26th 2020 3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time - Year A - Matthew 4:12 - 23

In this week's gospel we see the arrest of John the Baptist and Jesus starting his ministry in Galilee at the extreme end of the Holy Land. This was a symbol of Jesus bringing God 'to the ends of the earth.' Jesus began his teaching with the message "Repent for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." He is calling people to have a change of heart, to a new way of seeing and doing things. Jesus went and invited the two brothers Simon and Andrew, two fishermen to join him. Then he saw James and John who were also brothers and fishermen to join him. The four followed him at once. Jesus then went about his work of proclaiming the Good News to all.

What way would we respond if Jesus invited us to leave all and follow him to bring His good news to people?
