February 25th 2018 2nd Sunday of Lent - Year B - Mark 9:2 - 10

In this week's gospel we see Jesus appearing in glory to the apostles. He took Peter, James and John up a high mountain before He became transfigured in their presence. This is a symbol of the painful journey the apostles must make with Jesus. On their journey with Jesus they get covered by a cloud and yet it is from within this cloud that they experience a renewed commitment to Him.

When are the times in our lives when a dark cloud has covered us in shadows and we found it hard to keep our commitments? Who were the Jesus people who brought us out of our darkness into a new light?

Thank you Lord for the transfiguration experiences we often have when we allow the Word of God to enter our hearts.
