## April 4<sup>th</sup> 2021 Easter Sunday – Year B – John 20: 1 - 10

In this week's gospel we see that the open tomb is a big part of the Easter story. When Mary of Magdala visits the tomb on the third day after Jesus is crucified, she finds that the stone has been moved away. The realisation gradually dawns that something wonderful has happened. Jesus is risen from the dead. Because the hearts of Mary and the disciples were opened that first Easter morning they understood what Jesus had been trying to teach them all along.
