Feast of the Trinity – Year B – Matthew 28:16-20

In this week's gospel we read about Jesus going to the mountain to meet the eleven disciples. He spoke to them of the authority that had been given to him and then he told them to "go and make disciples of all nations baptising them in the name of the father and of the son and of the Holy Spirit and teach them to observe the commandments he gave them.
