 - **Action** – Attitude (Call to change / to act / to do)

February 24th 2013 2nd Sunday in Lent – Year C – Luke 9:28-36

In this week's gospel we see Jesus taking his three followers up the mountain to pray. This is a symbol of the withdrawal that must take place before he can be transfigured. We see that the change occurred as Jesus was praying and then we see the two men talking to Jesus about his passion. It was while the apostles were covered with a cloud that they experienced the glory of Jesus through a heavenly voice.

Are there times in our lives when we felt there was a great cloud between us and God? Then during our prayers we became transfigured and realised Jesus was there all the time.

Prayer:

Thank you Lord for all the deep experiences in our lives and for the insights that changed our whole way of thinking.

Forgive us for the times we did not listen without our prejudices and judgemental selves to people who God has chosen to stand before us at any moment in time.

Help us not to be frightened when we seem to be in a cloud and we do not know what to do. Show us how to trust in Jesus and believe that he will guide us through if we but listen to him.
