In this week's gospel we read about the first miracle of Jesus. He saved a newly married couple from embarrassment after running out of wine. Jesus revealed himself and performed this miracle because he was asked to do it by his mother who felt for these young people. Mary is a woman of deep empathy. Jesus unable to deny his mother's request performs his miracle. This shows us the great favour Mary has with her son Jesus and our requests to her will be carried in the same way to her Son. By listening to his Mother and performing this miracle Jesus let his glory be seen and his disciples believed in Him.
