December 20th 2015 4th Sunday of Advent - Year C - Luke 1:39 - 44

In this weeks gospel we read about Mary's pregnancy. We reflect on the visitation - the second joyful mystery of the rosary. Mary is the main focus of our attention as she awaits the birth of Jesus.
