### January 13<sup>th</sup> 2019 Sunday Feast of Baptism of Our Lord - Year C - Luke 3 15-16,21 - 22

In this week's gospel we read that Jesus was at prayer after his baptism when the heaven opened and the Holy Spirit descended like a dove. When Jesus approached John for Baptism John was uneasy. He protested but Jesus wanted to show how important the action was and his baptism was his call to Public Ministry. It often happens that a call to do Gods work is proceeded by a deep experience of God through meditation or prayer. Our Baptism is a sign of us being the children of God and are the unique work of His hands.

This experience of Jesus occurred when he was at prayer. What part has prayer played in your life helping you to realise the part God is playing in your life?
