– Annual Pilgrimage to Knock will take place on Sat.27<sup>th</sup> June Cost €45 please see notices in Church Porch for more details.

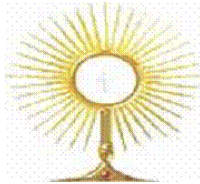


**HOUSE TO HOUSE –NEW ENVELOPES**
