As for Sundays and St Patrick's Day – we will just have one mass like the Pope in Santa Martha not open to the public celebrated in the church and on-line at 10am. Now the Holy Father has Swiss Guards to stop entry, I depend on your good sense and civic spirit. However I propose that on these days after the mass I will be available until 1230 and happy to give individuals Holy Communion.

These are extraordinary times and as the Tanaiste said normally in times of crisis we come together, but at this unique time of crisis we are asked not to come together but to pray for each other at home, or in empty but safer churches.
