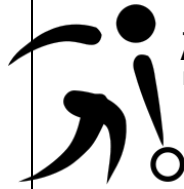

## Reflection on Sunday's Gospel

### The Word of God Does Not Go on Holidays.

20th Sunday Ordinary Time 16th August 2015 John 6:51-58

In today's gospel Jesus gives the people a teaching based on their experience of the miraculous feeding for the third time. In the two previous passages Jesus presented himself as 'bread came down from heaven'. In this one 'he gives them his flesh to eat and his blood to drink'. He tells them that he gives himself totally, every part of his being is at their service. He is inviting us to 'have his spirit coursing through us', so that each one can know his love. He wants us to unite our weakness and suffering with his so that we can experience his strength and his courage. Who are the people who support your faith and help you draw life from Jesus? Lord help us to remain silent rather than talking too much so that we may become conscious of Jesus present within us.
