20th Sunday Ordinary Time 16th August 2015 John 6:51-58

In todays gospel Jesus gives the people a teaching based on their experience of the miraculous feeding for the third time. In the two previous passages Jesus presented himself as 'bread came down from heaven'. In this one 'he gives them his flesh to eat and his blood to drink'. He tells them that he gives himself totally, every part of his being is at their service. He is inviting us to 'have his spirit coursing through us', so that each one can know his love.
