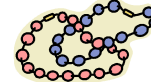

Lenten Reflection 2nd Sunday in Lent Year A Matthew 17: 1-9

In this week's Gospel we see Jesus appearing in glory to the apostles. He took Peter, James & John



up to a high mountain before He can be transfigured in their presence. This is a symbol of the painful journey the apostles must make with Jesus.
