At present, St. MacDara's is celebrating twenty five years of educational provision to the local community. Its anniversary magazine is available from the Parish Office at a cost of 5 euro per copy. Various celebrations have been taking place during this academic year to mark this special occasion. These include a student production of "Carmen", a visit by the Minister for Education and Science, Ms. Mary Hanafin, to an "Afternoon of Music and Art" and a special Awards Night in late May. Given the commitment of the local clubs and the school itself to sporting involvement by students, it was perhaps fitting that St. MacDara's achieved the unique honour of being selected as the top sporting school in Leinster at the Annual Evening Herald School Sports Awards Ceremony which was held in Croke Park this past week. The achievements which singled out the school from other schools, including many fee-paying schools who employ paid external coaches, included; Dublin Colleges Senior Camogie League Champions (Div.1); Dublin Colleges under 16 Boys 'A' Hurling Champions, Dublin and Leinster Boys under 14 League (Div. 1) Soccer Champions plus various other camogie, rugby and Gaelic football successes. The College acknowledges the commitment of teachers and the great work done over the years by the local Primary schools and local clubs. Without their efforts this wonderful achievement would not have occurred.
