The atrium is a specially prepared room in **St. Jude's Parish Centre**. It is a sacred, quiet environment where children can work with beautiful materials, which allow them to draw deeper into the essentials of our faith. At St. Jude's, we have three levels to our Atrium; Level I: 3 – 6 years old; Level II: 6 – 9 years old and level III: 9 – 12 years old. The "method" we use in the atrium is known as the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. Based on the principles of Montessori, the children learn about their Catholic faith in a very hands-on, concrete and joy-filled way.
