**PLEASE NOTE NEW OPENING AND CLOSING TIMES FOR CHURCH FROM MONDAY 9TH NOVEMBER**

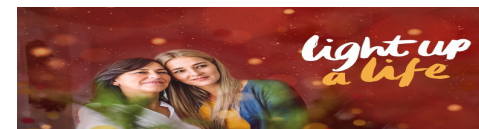
The Church will open each day Monday to Friday after Morning Mass for Private prayer and adoration until 4pm If we have a funeral Church will be closed until 1PM
