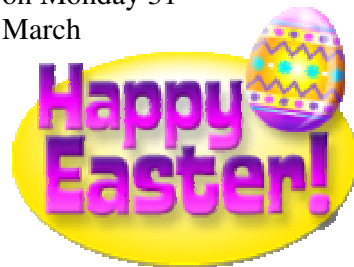

**Reflection for Easter Sunday YEAR A -2008**

Matthew 28: 1-10
