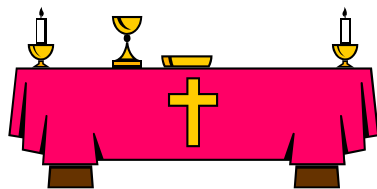

A little information on Taize.

In 1940 a young Swiss man named Roger settled in the tiny village of Taizé, France. There he offered shelter and hiding to political refugees. Particular Jews. At the same time, he gathered around him a few men of different denominations. This was the beginning of a great ecumenical community. Here in the Parish of St Jude the Apostle the Taizé mass is celebrated on the Last Sunday of the month from September to April, and each Sunday in Advent & Lent. The Mass is a normal Sunday Mass. The mood is set by candlelight & quite reflective music called Taizé chants which help to maintain a peaceful, prayerful atmosphere. We look forward to seeing you on the 30<sup>th</sup> September

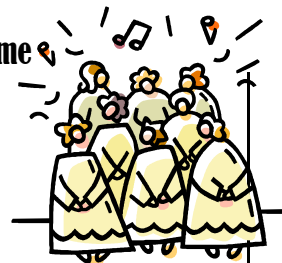
#### The Priory Institute
