Marmion Dom Marmion was a priest of Dublin Diocese who  
ministered in Dundrum before teaching in Holy Cross College. In  
2000, parishioners of Dundrum celebrated his beatification and  
continue to pray for his intercession. The Dom Marmion Society,
