Lenten Reflection

3rd Sunday In Lent – Year A John 4 5-30

In this week's Gospel we see Jesus meeting with the Samaritan woman at the well. Notice how Jesus meets the woman where she is at needing her assistance because He is thirsty and needs a drink of water. See how He is patient with her but also challenges her to grow to what she is capable of. At first the woman is content with the water she draws from the well but Jesus gradually leads her to search for another kind of water that when you drink it you do not get thirsty again as it comes from the spring inside you.



When have you made a similar journey in your relationship with God? Recognise the times you resisted the challenge of Jesus to grow to what you are capable of with Him by your side guiding you?
