The NRA and SDCC have statutory and moral obligations to mitigate the impact of these two pollutants on our environment and indeed they are planning to take a number of significant measures such as the acceptance that an increase in Air and Noise Pollution is to be expected. We are asking all Associations, Sporting bodies, concerned citizens and **ANYONE** who uses and enjoys the Park to write or email (so easy now) to both the NRA (info@nra.ie) (copy to fcoffey@sdublincoco.ie outlining your concerns and asking what proactive measures are being taken to protect our community and all users of the wonderful facility that is Tymon Park. These measures must **NOT** be the minimum but rather what is the **BEST** for years to come to incorporate noise reducing tarmac on **ALL** lanes. Best quality sound barrier, higher and the full length of the park and as well as more trees planted this year along the motorway. We should be guaranteed regular monitoring of both the Noise and Air Pollution for our area.
