### The First Collection at Mass

The first collection at mass supports the priests of the Archdiocese including retired and sick priests of the diocese. The money collected goes directly to a common fund from which all priests are paid a monthly allowance.

### The Second Collection at mass.

The second collection at mass unless otherwise stated is the **Share** collection.

**Share** was originally set up in the 1970s to provide funding to meet the needs of new and developing parishes like St. Judes. In more recent years, however, as the need for new churches diminished, Share has been used to refurbish parish churches, build parish pastoral centers and fund the diocesan administration of central services.

The share collection is replaced by 7 special collections during the year.
