New Government guidelines on return to Mass came into effect May 10<sup>th</sup> we are allowed to have 2 pods of 45 with social distancing in place

Under these new guidelines we have decided to do away with the Monday to Friday tickets and will allow the 1<sup>st</sup> 90 people to come along each day we hope this will allow as many of you who wish to come to mass at least one day a week to do so we would ask that you do not start queuing outside doors before 9.15 as we will have to sanitise church each morning before you come in and after you leave.
