## Reflection on Last Sunday's Gospel

**The Word of God does not go  
on holidays.  
13<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time  
Mark 5:21-43**

Ronald Rolheiser has a lovely way  
of using the story of the woman  
touching the hem of Christ's  
garment to encourage parents  
whose children no longer practice  
the faith of who find themselves  
estranged from the Church. He  
stresses that what each of us does  
for others (as the Body of Christ,  
his Church and in Christ's names)  
is an extension of Christ's ministry.  
When we forgive someone we  
communicate Christ's forgiveness:  
when we comfort someone, we  
extend Christ's comfort to them.  
When parents continue to love,  
care for, comfort, listen to, and  
forgive their adult children, these  
family members, although no  
longer practising are nevertheless  
touching them with Christ's  
garment.
