Reflection on Sunday's Gospel

The Word of God Does Not Go on Holidays.

19th Sunday Ordinary Time 9th August, 2015 John 6:41-51

Today's gospel shows Jesus disputing with those who (understandably) cannot understand his claim to be flesh that is eaten for eternal life. How can he be saying these things after all we know his family. He is a local and just an ordinary person in their eyes. Jesus asks them to look beyond that same ordinary reality and recognise two things: a) that the meeting with him is not by chance but by God's grace; and b) that it is a meeting that has great significance, not merely here and now but for all eternity. The Christian community is the Body of Christ. St. Paul asks us to stop moaning and 'be friends' . In the Body of Christ gathered around his table we become friends with God and with one another. As Jesus put a human face on God, let us with Gods help be the means of bringing this love to one another.
